### Congregational Meeting 2010 – Sunday, March 7

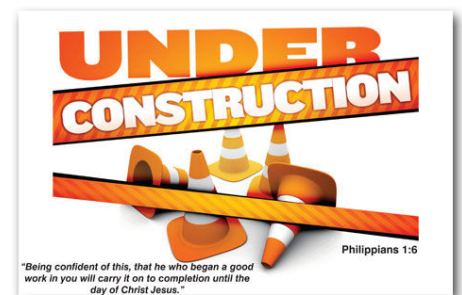

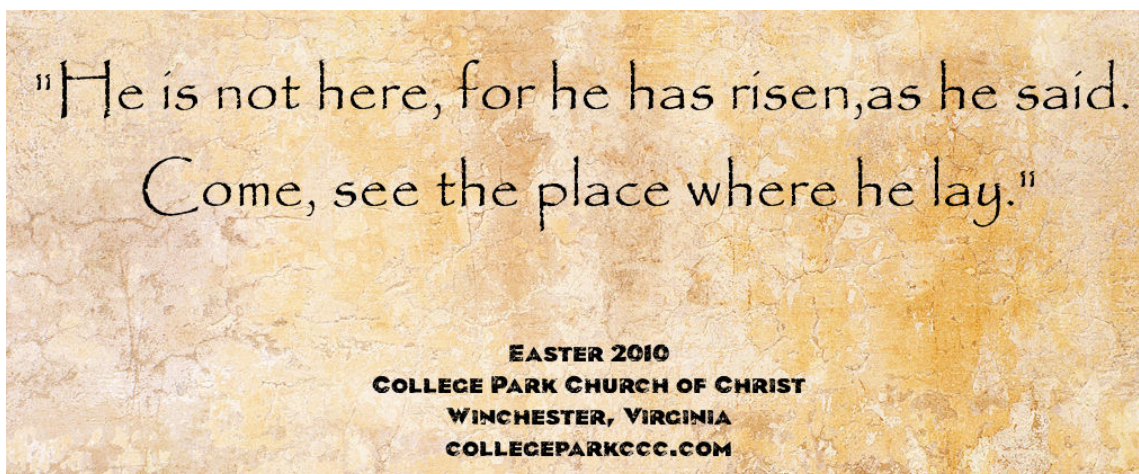
**Friday, April 2, 2010: Good Friday Service**

## MARCH SERMONS

This January we began a series of sermons from the book of Nehemiah. This is a book about building God's city, both physically (chapters 1-6) and spiritually (chapters 7-13). God has called his church to build a city set on a hill (Matthew 5:14).

### **Sunday, March 7, 2010**

#### The Sword and the Trowel

Text: Nehemiah 4:15-23

*Key Verses:* Those who carried burdens were loaded in such a way that each labored on the work with one hand and held his weapon with the other. And each of the builders had his sword strapped at his side while he built. The man who sounded the trumpet was beside me.

### **Sunday, March 14, 2010**

#### Repentance and Worship

Text: Nehemiah 5:1-13

*Key Verse:* Then they said, "We will restore these and require nothing from them. We will do as you say." And I called the priests and made them swear to do as they had promised. I also shook out the fold of my garment and said, "So may God shake out every man from his house and from his labor who does not keep this promise. So may he be shaken out and emptied." And all the assembly said "Amen" and praised the LORD. And the people did as they had promised.
